

Player Code of Conduct

All players are expected to treat all coaches, managers, players, umpires, spectators, and league & game officials with respect. Players will be respectful of the ballpark and the game. Remember it is a privilege to play the game.

All players are expected to conduct themselves in the following manner;

- Be on time for all games, practices and all team functions.
- Be responsible for your own equipment
- Let your coach know ahead of time if you are going to be absent.
- Take responsibility for your own actions.
- Be courteous to the umpires, the other team and its coaches.
- Cheering during the game should be for encouraging your teammates and not against the other team.
- Pick up after yourself and dispose of trash within the ballpark.
- Any verbal or physical abuse of a player, coach, manager, game or league official will result in disciplinary action as outlined in section 7.01 of the SSBA operational By-Laws. Any appeal process will be dealt with in accordance to Sections 5.05 & section 5.06 of the same By-Laws.

All Players have a responsibility to represent Sault Ste Marie, and the Soo Select Black Sox in a manner that everyone is proud of. All players need to lead by example, with no exceptions to this rule.
